## SMALL GROUP GUIDE

Blessed to be bold - Psalm 2

**GATHER**: Groups open with a short time of casual fellowship and/or icebreaker.

**GROW**: Most of the group's time should be spent studying God's Word and prayer.

- REVIEW
  - Big Idea of the present series: The series focuses on studying individual Psalms, which show believers why God should be praised while helping them to disciples their feelings, thoughts, and actions in a way that grows to glorify Christ.
  - Today's key text: Psalm 2
  - Main Idea of the Text: While Psalms 1 shows the fate of those who delight in the Lord, Psalms 2 shows what will happen to those who defy the Lord while pointing to Christ as the only option for salvation.
  - Main Idea of the Message: In Christ, we are BLESSED with eternal life to be BOLD for the Lord.
  - Presented Applications: Live like Christ died for you. (Ps.2:10-12)
    - PT Forsythe, "The first duty of every soul is not to find its freedom but its Master."
- REFLECT
  - How did this past text challenge you?
  - How did this past text encourage you?
  - What other Bible verses might relate to the text?
    - Acts 4:24-31, John 8:34-36, Rev 17:14, Matt 21:38, Luke 19:14, 1
      Peter 2:7-8, Prov 1:26, Is. 66:1, Philippians 2:12, Hebrews 12:25
  - What is ONE thing you plan to do as a result of the day's Bible Study?
  - How can we pray for you today?

GO: Participants are encouraged to follow up with each other afterward.

## Small Group Leader Tips

- Listen to the sermon and read the text at least one day before your group meets.
- Your goal is to listen more than speak. Add short commentaries to engage further conversation.
- Manage the conversation by asking participants questions
  - Ex.1 Asking them to further explain what they said
  - *Ex.2 Asking someone else to contribute*
- Try to connect conversations with participants.
- *Pray for your participants throughout the week.*
